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1. Identification of the Substance/Preparation and Company

Product Name: Tri Calcium Phosphate (TCP) – IP Grade

Chemical Formula: $\text{Ca}_3(\text{PO}_4)_2$

Synonyms: Tricalcium phosphate, Calcium phosphate tribasic

Use of Substance: Pharmaceutical excipient, food additive, nutritional supplement.

2. Hazards Identification

- **Classification (GHS):** Not classified as hazardous.
- **Hazard Statements:** May cause mild irritation to eyes, skin, or respiratory tract.
- **Precautionary Statements:**
 - Avoid dust inhalation.
 - Wash hands after handling.
 - Use in well-ventilated areas.

3. Composition / Information on Ingredients

- **Chemical Name:** Tri Calcium Phosphate

- **Purity:** ≥ 98%

4. First Aid Measures

- **Inhalation:** Move person to fresh air; seek medical attention if irritation persists.
- **Skin Contact:** Wash thoroughly with soap and water.
- **Eye Contact:** Rinse cautiously with plenty of water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present.
- **Ingestion:** Rinse mouth and drink water. Seek medical advice if large amount swallowed.

5. Fire Fighting Measures

- **Suitable Extinguishing Media:** Water, foam, CO₂, or dry chemical.
- **Fire Hazards:** Product is non-combustible.
- **Protective Equipment:** Firefighters should wear protective gear and self-contained breathing apparatus.

6. Accidental Release Measures

- Handle in well-ventilated areas.
 - Avoid inhalation of dust.

 - Protect from moisture.

 - **Respiratory Protection:** Dust mask/respirator if airborne concentrations are high.
 - **Eye Protection:** Safety glasses with side shields.

- **Appearance:** White, odourless, crystalline powder.
 - **Molecular Weight:** 310.18 g/mol
 - **Solubility:** Practically insoluble in water.
 - **pH (suspension):** 6.5 – 8.5
 - **Melting Point:** Decomposes on heating.
 - **Density:** 3.14 g/cm³
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10. Stability and Reactivity

- **Stability:** Stable under recommended conditions.
 - **Conditions to Avoid:** Excessive moisture, strong acids.
 - **Incompatible Materials:** Strong acids (releases phosphoric acid and calcium salts).
 - **Hazardous Decomposition Products:** Calcium oxide and phosphorus oxides on heating.
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11. Toxicological Information

- **Acute Toxicity:** Low toxicity.
 - **Inhalation:** May cause mild irritation to respiratory tract.
 - **Skin Contact:** Not irritating under normal conditions.
 - **Eye Contact:** Dust may cause mild irritation.
