Menthol Crystal Large 100% Pure appears as a colorless to white crystalline solid with a characteristic minty odor. It has a melting point of approximately 41 to 44°C and a boiling point of about 212°C. The substance is slightly soluble in water but freely soluble in alcohol, chloroform, and ether. It possesses a flash point around 93°C (closed cup) and a specific gravity of approximately 0.89. The product is neutral in pH and exhibits a vapor pressure of about 0.05 mmHg at 25°C.

10. Stability and Reactivity

Stability: Stable under normal conditions.

Conditions to Avoid: Heat, sparks, and open flames.

Incompatible Materials: Strong oxidizing agents.

Decomposition Products: Carbon monoxide and carbon dioxide.

11. Toxicological Information
