Physical Properties

- Solubility: Practically insoluble in water; soluble in dilute acids.

Shelf Life & Storage

- Shelf Life: 5 years from date of manufacture under recommended storage.
- Storage Conditions: Store in a cool, dry, and well-ventilated area. Keep container tightly closed and protected from moisture, heat, and direct sunlight. Avoid contact with incompatible materials. Place bags on pallets above floor level to prevent moisture absorption. Use original sealed packaging for best stability.

Applications

- Use: Source of calcium and phosphorus mineral supplement in animal feed. Supports proper bone and teeth formation in growing animals. Supports milk production and skeletal health. Provides essential minerals for fish and shrimp development. Common ingredient in mineral premixes and veterinary feed supplements. Used in pet food formulations as a mineral fortifier.
- Dosage: Depends on species, age, diet composition, and existing calcium/phosphorus levels in the feed. Final inclusion should be set by an animal nutritionist.

Packaging

- Standard Packing: 25 kg woven PP bags with inner liner, 1 kgs and 100 grams or as per customer requirement.
- Labeling: Product name, batch number, net weight, manufacture date, expiry date, and manufacturer details.
