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1. Identification of the Substance/Preparation and of the Company

- **Chemical Name:** Zinc Oxide Dross
- **Synonyms:** ZnO Dross, Zinc Slag
- **CAS Number:** 1314-13-2 (Zinc Oxide)

2. Composition / Information on Ingredients

- **Zinc Oxide:** 80–95%
- **Other trace metals:** Iron, Lead, Cadmium (depending on source)
- **Impurities:** Small quantities of metallic residues

3. Hazard Identification

- **Emergency Overview:** White to gray powder, low solubility in water, may cause irritation to eyes, skin, and respiratory tract.

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4. First-Aid Measures

- **Inhalation:** Move to fresh air; if breathing is difficult, seek medical attention.
 - **Skin Contact:** Wash with soap and water; remove contaminated clothing.
 - **Eye Contact:** Rinse thoroughly with water for at least 15 minutes; seek medical attention if irritation persists.
 - **Ingestion:** Do not induce vomiting; rinse mouth and seek medical advice.
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5. Fire-Fighting Measures

- **Flammability:** Non-combustible.
 - **Suitable Extinguishing Media:** Use water spray, dry chemical, foam, or CO₂.
 - **Special Firefighting Procedures:** Wear protective equipment; avoid inhalation of smoke.
